

## **PURPOSE:**

To assist low-income families in the Upper Dauphin with food needs.

House next to Halifax United Methodist Church

## **HOURS:**

Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday from 9:00 A. M. – 11:00 A. M.

Tuesday and Thursday from 4:00 P. M. – 6:00 P. M.

## **GUIDELINES**

- A. Recipients must meet the income eligibility guidelines. They are reviewed yearly.
- B. Each family unit may receive meats, cereal, pasta, etc. twice a month.
- C. Breads and pastries are given on an as needed basis.
- D. Each family must sign a liability disclosure that we are not responsible for any reason for food received through this food ministry.

## **EASTER AND CHRISTMAS**

- A. A ham is given to each family at Easter.
- B. A food basket with a turkey, and gifts for younger children, is given at Christmas.

## **FOOD SUPPLIES**

Food and cash contributions are received from the following areas:

## **VOLUNTEERS**

The Food Ministry is operated by volunteers on a daily basis.

- a. A volunteer picks up breads and pastries at a local supermarket seven days a week.
- b. Volunteers distribute the food six days a week.
- c. Volunteers pick up food once a month at the Central Pennsylvania Food Bank.
